Priority 1: To improve the quality of education (including in EYFS)

- Develop teaching staff to be pedagogical experts
- Develop practitioner subject knowledge across the wider curriculum
- Improve outcomes in reading and phonics
- Develop EYFS pedagogical experts and curriculum
- Develop a data strategy across the Trust
- Increase maths outcomes
- Increase writing outcomes
- Embed whole class feedback and live feedback
- Develop our curriculum offer
